Subject: Relaxation in certain provisions of The National Commission for Homoeopathy (Minimum Essential Standards for Homoeopathic Colleges and Attached Hospitals), Regulations – 2024, for permission to admission in Undergraduate course BHMS AY 2025-26– reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the above cited subject, the undersigned is to convey the decision taken during the 11th Special meeting of the NCH held on 8th April 2025 as below for necessary compliance by all the homoeopathic colleges:

- Teaching Staff: 10% relaxation for 100 seats and 15% relaxation for 60 seats UG course college in the required total strength of faculty members as per Minimum Essential Standards (MES) Regulations 2024.
- ii. Non-Teaching Staff: 20% relaxation in the required total strength of non-teaching staff of college and hospital.
- iii. **Hospital Bed Strength:** The college hospital shall enhance the existing bed strength (25 beds for 100 seats & 20 beds for 60 seats) by minimum 20% each year in phased manner to achieve the required total bed strength of 50 beds and 30 beds respectively in five years.
- iv. Laboratory / Departmental Equipment's & Instruments: There shall be a relaxation of 10% in the regulatory requirements of the laboratory / departmental equipment's & instruments. However, there shall be no relaxation in the Emergency Equipment's at SI. No. 12 (Appendix 15) and Skill Laboratory at SI. No. 15 of the Paragraph A-General of the Second Schedule of the MES Regulations.
- v. Enhancement in UG seats from 60: All existing institutions & colleges with 60 seats in UG course may apply for enhancement of seats to 100 as per the regulatory provisions irrespective of their year of establishment.
- vi. An opportunity of hearing shall be given to college for substantiating the claim of compliance for the indicated deficiencies during the inspection, before conveying the decision.
